## **CHANGES TO LOOK FORWARD TO IN 2020**

- **SCHOOL UNIFORM:** From next year learners will be required to always be in complete school uniform before being allowed into the school premises. Parents should note that, if learners come to school wearing any colours outside our uniform code, you will be called to come and pick your child. Our uniform distinguishes our learners from other learners, therefore it is important that our learners are addressed appropriately for easy identification should anything happen on their way to school or on their way back home. Kindly order your jersey, pullover and school tie at the reception.
- **SCHOOL FEES:** From next year, parents and guardians can use the debit order system as an alternative for fees payment. This is to ease parents the burden of joining long queues during month end and also losing deposit slips. Also if you choose the debit order option you get a substantive discount on your monthly fees. You can get more information from the reception.
- **ACCESS GATE SYSTEM:** This year we introduced the access gate system to ensure security of our learners. Please note that in 2020, your child's access card will be customized as a student card for your child. We will print over your child's card, his picture, grade, student number, emergency contact numbers etc. This is only going to cost an extra R 10. Please note that your child will use the same card they were issued this year.

### **2020 Re-registration**

***For continuing students; please note that the re-registration fee is still R 300.00. Please make sure your registration form reaches the reception before the 15<sup>th</sup> of Jan 2020, to ensure that you are captured on our system for the 2020 academic year. Also note that as a parent if you refer another parent and they do register, you get a R 100 for each successful registration.***
